She worked on the monthly newsletter, was on-site for the mold remediation project and conducted Rehearsal & Officiated at the wedding of Shelby Cessna & Michael Fox. She was on vacation from Oct 24-Oct 31st.

In Nov Pastor Sheila conducted 4 worship services, served Communion, Attended 2 Committee mtgs and the Thanksgiving Church Dinner. She made the following visits: 4 Nursing Homes; 1 Home & Youth; 2 Office Appts. She attended the Dayton Ministerium Mtg and participated in the Dayton Community Light Up Night. Pastor Sheila attended the Presbytery Mtg and the Kiski Presbytery Ladies Luncheon as well as worked on the monthly newsletter.

Session approved the appointment of Steffani Winslow as Treasurer and Joanne Colligan as Clerk of Session for 2024. The Terms of Call for Pastor Sheila Wadding were approved.

Presbytery Business: Session approved the appointment of Joanne Colligan as Elder Commissioner for Presbytery. Pastor Sheila and Joanne attended the Nov 4th meeting. Approved the restructuring of the Presbytery. Rev. Don Wilson announced his retirement. At the Dec 5th mtg approved the nominees for committees and the General Assembly representative. Approved Parental/Leave etc. policy and Manual of Operations.

New Business: We will participate in the International Peace Light Program.

A motion was approved to close the meeting. Pastor Sheila adjourned the meeting with prayer at 8:00 p.m. The next meeting will be on January 18, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. in the Academy.
